FORM 01 · A · NOTICE TO U.S. AIR CARGO SHIPPERS

Advance Blanket Notification — Consent to Search All Air Cargo.

49 USC 114 authorizes the collection of this information.

Dear Shipper,

Effective February 01, 2009, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requires all forwarders to have a written consent to screen, on file from the shipper, prior to offering any cargo to an air carrier.

The information you provide to **PressEx Logistics, LLC** will be used to qualify you or verify your status as a possible "Known Shipper." Providing this information is voluntary. However, failure to provide it will prevent you from qualifying as a "Known Shipper." This information will be disclosed to TSA personnel and contractors or other agents including IACs in the maintenance and operation of the known shipper program. TSA may share the information with airport operators, foreign air carriers, IACs, law enforcement agencies, and others in accordance with the Privacy Act, 5 USC §552a.

While we will do our best to minimize any inconvenience to our customers and industry partners, we are committed to the safety of the traveling public and will diligently carry out all of our responsibilities to ensure the security of the transportation supply chain.

To avoid any interruption of service, PressEx is requesting that you copy the required verbiage (ABNCSAC Form, next page) onto your company letterhead, complete it in full, and return it to your PressEx representative.

Although this consent may appear on any shipper document you provide, it must be complete and contain the entire verbiage on the next page. Having the completed blanket notification document on file will cover all shipments tendered by you, eliminating the risk of delay and/or refusal.

Per 49 CFR Parts 15 and 1520, the details of any screening processes applied to cargo, the criteria used to make such determination, and any advance routing details may not be disclosed.

The FPPI acknowledges that it is the responsibility of each U.S. shipper (USPPI) to provide said Authorized Agent with certain export commodity data, and acknowledges that **no goods shall be exported** until such time that said Authorized Agent obtains this information in good order from said USPPI.

The FPPI further acknowledges that **civil and criminal penalties** may be imposed by CBP for making false or fraudulent statements or for violation of any U.S. laws or regulations on exportation.

Authorized Agent of the FPPI — §30.3(e)(2)

- Obtain a Power of Attorney or written authorization from the FPPI.
- Prepare and file the Electronic Export Information (EEI) based on information obtained from the USPPI or other parties involved in the transaction.
- Upon request, provide the USPPI with a copy of the POA or written authorization from the FPPI.
- Retain documentation to support the EEI reported through AES.
- Upon request, provide the USPPI with the export information that was provided by the USPPI and filed in AES.

USPPI in a routed export transaction — §30.3(e)(1)

- Provide the U.S. agent with statistical information including USPPI name and address, EIN, state of origin, Schedule B number, quantity/unit of measure, description of commodity, origin of goods, value, and any license information to assist in preparing the EEI.
- Retain documentation to support the information provided to the agent for preparing the EEI as specified in §30.10 of the Foreign Trade Regulations.

This written authorization is to remain in full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given by the FPPI and received by the authorized agent.

- 4. License Determination — License Nr / CFR Citation, DDTC Registration Number, DDTC Eligible Party Certification
- 5. Freight Forwarder — PressEx Logistics, LLC (ID Nr. 80-0900981)
- 6. Cargo Details — Shipment Type, Pieces, Weight, Dimensions
- 7. Special Instructions
- 8. Commodity Information — Description, Schedule B/HTS, ECCN/USML, Origin (D/F), Quantities, Gross Weight, Export Value, License Value
